Critical notes:

This score is part of the first modern edition of 2 concertos, "Concerto Ex D# a 8 Stim" and "Concerto Ex G# a 6 Stim" by a composer named "Sig^r Anderssen" in manuscripts kept at the University Library of Lund, Sweden. The manuscripts are number 107 and 108 of the collection "Samling Kraus" containing music performed in the middle of the 18th century by "Akademiska Kapellet", the orchestra of the University of Lund, see Greger Andersson, Musik av Johan Helmich Roman och hans samtida i Lunds universitetsbibliotek (<http://www.musikforskning.se/stm/STM1994/STM1994-95Andersson.pdf>).

The 2 concertos were copied to scores from the original instrumental parts in Lund by Danish musicians exiled in Sweden during the second world war. The copyists may have believed that the composer was of Danish origin, erroneously reading his name as "Andersen". These copied score are kept at the music department of the Royal Library, Copenhagen as mss. "C II, 25 Fol. 1945-46.219 C II, 25 Fol." and "C II, 25 Fol. 1945-46.218 C II, 25 Fol". My edition is primarily based on the scores from Copenhagen but checked against the instrumental parts from Lund.

Performance indications added by the editor are enclosed within brackets.
