Detailed description: This system covers measures 19 to 23. The upper staff (Or.) contains a melodic line with eighth and quarter notes, including accidentals (sharps and naturals). The lower staff (Ped.) provides a harmonic accompaniment with sustained notes and some rhythmic patterns.

Detailed description: This system covers measures 24 to 26. Measure 24 features a descending eighth-note scale in the upper staff. Measure 25 has a triplet of eighth notes in the upper staff and a five-measure phrase in the lower staff. Measure 26 continues with a six-measure phrase in the upper staff and a seven-measure phrase in the lower staff.

Detailed description: This system covers measures 27 to 29. Measure 27 has a quarter note in the upper staff and a triplet of eighth notes in the lower staff. Measure 28 features a triplet of eighth notes in the upper staff and a half note in the lower staff. Measure 29 has a triplet of eighth notes in the upper staff and a half note in the lower staff.

Detailed description: This system covers measures 30 to 34. Measures 30-31 feature triplets of eighth notes in both the upper and lower staves. Measures 32-34 continue with various rhythmic patterns and accidentals in both staves.

Detailed description: This system covers measures 35 to 39. Measures 35-36 feature triplets of eighth notes in both staves. Measure 37 has a 5/4 time signature change. Measures 38-39 continue with the 5/4 time signature and feature various rhythmic patterns and accidentals.

This system covers measures 39 to 42. The upper staff (Or.) is in 4/4 time and contains a melodic line with eighth and sixteenth notes, including a triplet of eighth notes in measure 40. The lower staff (Ped.) is in 4/4 time and features a bass line with a triplet of eighth notes in measure 40. The key signature has one sharp (F#).
