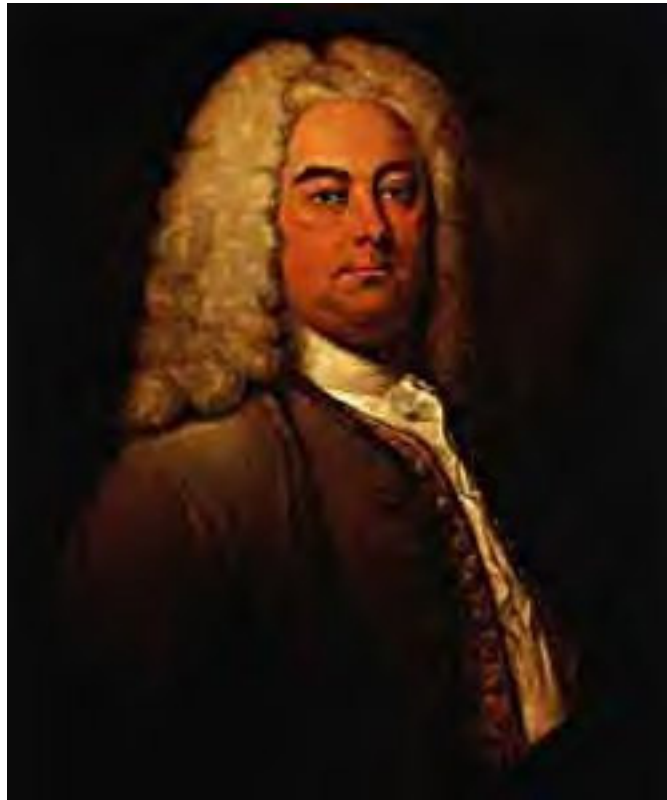

In measure 17, the cornets play a quarter note (A) followed by an eighth-note pair (G-A), while the trombones play eighth-note pairs (F-G and A-B).
