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
A PEDAL STUDY.

Note. In the study by Heller the Pedal must be put down at the second 16th note in each bar, and held down until the seventh sixteenth note. In the other one, the Pedal must be put down at the second and sixth eighth notes in each bar; otherwise everything will be con-fused. The same principle should be very generally applied in pianoforte music. For example; in the following extract from Chopin the Pedal must not be put down when the 1st, 4th, 7th, and 10th eighth notes are played, but just afterward; and in the Song Without Words of Mendelssohn it must be put down when the second 16th





NOTE. The player is advised to use the pedal in most measures of the studies thus: Put it down at the second and take it up at the seventh 16th note; instead of following the printed indications.



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
