Diese Partitur ist die späte Transkription eines 1996 (als die Computer der Musiker noch Atari hießen) in den Sequenzer (der damals noch "Notator" hieß) improvisierten, also ausnahmsweise schriftlos entstandenen Walzers. Dieser war Teil einer Reihe kurzer Bühnenmusiken für den Puppenspieler Dieter Baum (Theater "Sack un' Pack"), der damals zu einigen seiner Stücke kindgemäß Allerweltsmusik brauchte. Ich schwöre: die verblüffende Ähnlichkeit des Themas (das Wort sowohl im Sinne von Melodie als auch im Sinne von sujet oder Programm) mit Émile Waldteufels Schlittschuhwalzer resp. "Les patineurs" ist Zufall. Nicht einmal dessen Existenz war mir bekannt. Es ist einfach so: Wer im Zeitalter der Musikkonserve aufs tonale Idiom und noch dazu auf die typischen Stilmerkmale eines Genres zurückgreift, darf sich nicht wundern, wenn sich seine "Erfindung" in Teilen als unfreiwillige Reproduktion unbewußt aufgeschnappter, assoziierter und im passiven Gedächtnis abgelegter Muster herausstellt.
