





The word "Exercises" has often in the past been associated with dulness. The practice of special forms of technique is necessary, however, and exercises for the development of the pupil's powers are indispensable to all good teaching. They may equally well be used as short studies, and it is even possible to regard them as pieces when the special care which they require has made them perfect.

Teachers who move with the times will welcome these short studies. Though not very difficult they possess clear features of technique combined with great musical charm. Specially acceptable is the prominence given to the left hand, so often neglected in pianoforte studies. The composer's remarks, and suggestions for practice, are useful additions to a valuable and progressive work.

FIRST PIANO LESSONS-BOOK II

A third set of pieces, equally interesting and slightly harder than "Scenes at a Farm" and "Tunes from Nature." This book may, with great advantage, follow either or both of the foregoing, but is also suitable for independent use. Though written for the young, it is quite adapted to the needs of older pupils who may require very simple music.
