Definition of terms used

Pas de Basque.

Step right foot to side; slide left foot across in front of right; take the weight, and lift up behind; step on right, and extend left forward.

Arabesque.

Step diagonally forward on right foot, right hand extended diagonally forward or to fifth position, left raised in the rear, left hand extended to rear

Mazurka.

Step to right, weight on left foot, and hop; slide right foot to side; bring left foot up, and take the weight; extend right foot, bring right foot in and strike heels sharply.

Balance.

Step right foot to side; point left foot in fourth position; rise on toes and fall.

Jeté.

A leap

Draw.

Step right foot to right; turn the body toward the pointing toe, bending slightly forward; draw left foot to right and let it take the weight; turn the body to the front and stand erect.
