Spring has Splashy Rain ...



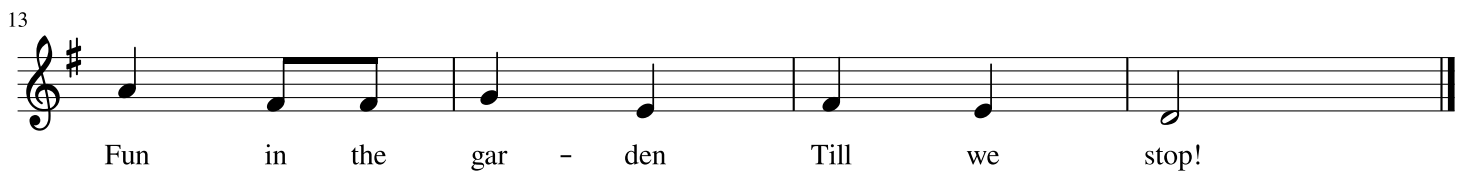
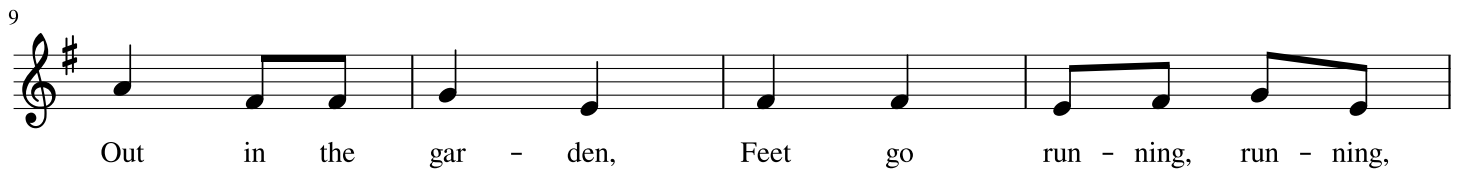
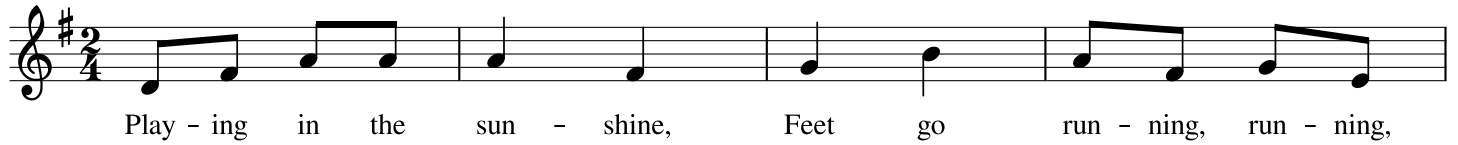
Spring	has	splash - y	rain,	Makes	the	pudd - les	fill;

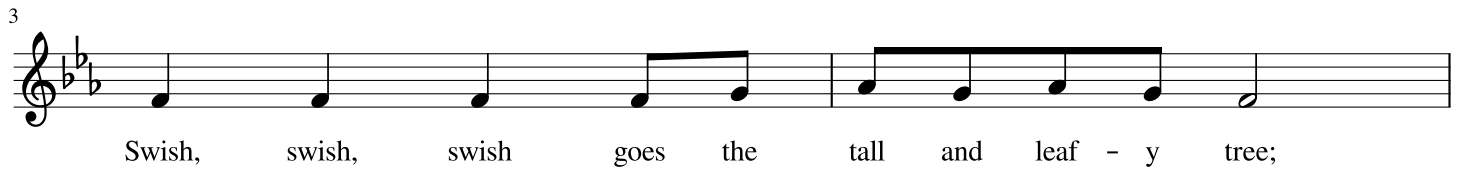
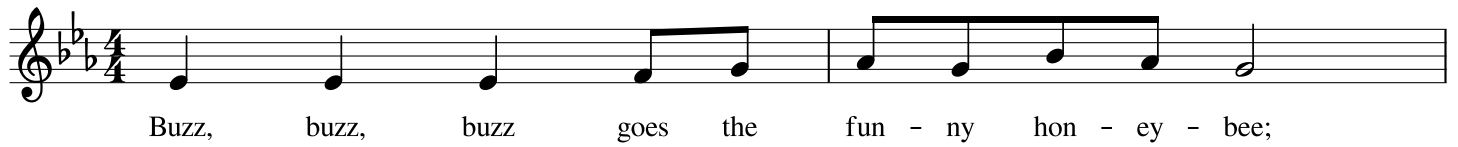


Wa - ter	in	the	streams	flows	Gent - ly	down	the	hill.
