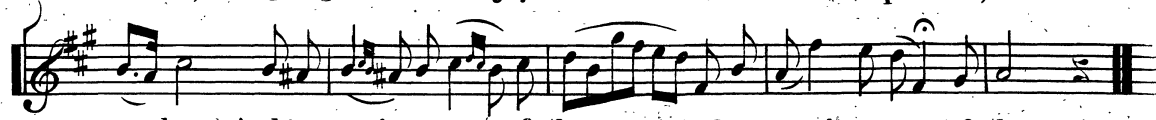

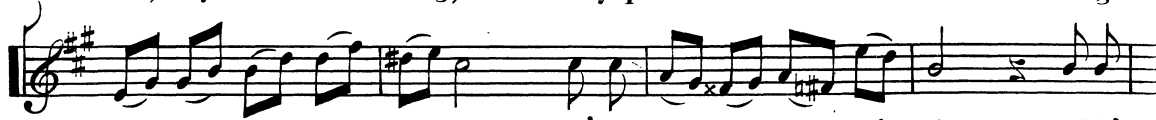

Still on thee my thoughts are dwelling, Whatso-e'er thy name may be; Beauti-



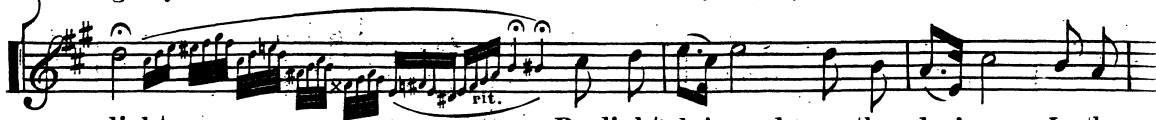
