WOLFGANG AMADEUS MOZART (1756–1791): *Serenade in C minor*, K 388 (probably 1782). Arranged for wind quintet (flute, oboe, clarinet in B^b, horn in F, bassoon) by Jesper Jerkert (1975–). Score in C.

The original score comprises 2 oboes, 2 clarinets in B^b, 2 horns in E^b, and 2 bassoons. Mozart later transcribed the work for string quintet (K 406/516b). The present arrangement has been made from the original wind octet version, as given in the NMA edition. Dynamical indications that have been added in comparison to the NMA edition are bracketed.
