- Measure 29:** Starts with a rest followed by a sixteenth note. The first measure ends with a trill instruction (*tr*) over four measures.

Performance instructions include:

- vib.*: Vibraphone sustain or similar effect.
- tr*: Trill.
- 212*: A specific performance technique or rhythm pattern.
- 01*: Another specific performance technique or rhythm pattern.
- 24*: A specific performance technique or rhythm pattern.

Anmerkungen / Remarks

Als *Ruggiero* (oder *Rujero* bei Sanz) wird ein variiertes Bass-Modell verstanden. Bei Letzterem folgt *Paradetas* als Nachtanz im Dreiertakt.^{†), ‡)}

Die Wiederholungsteile sind hier etwas nach Gusto angepasst worden.

Ruggiero (Sanz: *Rujero*) is a varied bass formula often paired with a triple-time variation, here the *Paradetas*.^{†), ‡)}

The repetition parts are changed a bit with gusto.
