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The following little Pieces are humbly submitted to the Perusal of those who on Days set apart for Devotion, might wish to take the Aid of Music, in raising the Mind to a Contemplation of the DIVINE GOODNESS to Man. The Subjects are General, and (as in the Eight Anthems for Cathedrals) the Words are Selected from different parts of the HOLY WRITINGS, so as to accord with the Title prefixed to each Anthem.

In Order to render them the more useful for Families, or private musical Parties, they seldom require more than Three Voices; but the Effect may be considerably improved by more Voices joining in those Places marked TUTTI.

The Solos and Duets are in the Treble Cliff; yet they may be sung by Tenor Voices; for the Tenor Cliff is only introduced in Chorus where it could not be avoided. — Repeats may be made where it may seem necessary, very few being marked: and Figures are purposely omitted except where the Harmony might appear to be doubtful.
