Wedding Anthem for Organ and Choir

Written for the marriage of Hilary Taylor and Noel Woodhead, Saturday 27th March 1993.

In this piece the Organ represents Life and the Choir, the Man and Woman. A short organ prelude introduces the Verse. The Man and Woman are heard their vows. The voices alternate and are separate in key. Even when they join in duet the lines remain parallel in different keys as two individual lives.

The texture thickens for the Refrain. The intensity of commitment increases, reflected by the use of canonic imitation. Plain vertical chords are used for its climactic statement.

Life bursts upon them. A sequence of bitonally remote organ chords portrays the world going about its business. Thematic material from the vow is heard underneath. Material from the Refrain brings us back to a reflective mood.

Verse II: The Man and Woman complement and support each other in their plea. Refrain is repeated.


Worldly busyness returns with another interlude for the organ. Life rushes forward at an ever increasing pace, before pulling back to leave a single note hanging. This leads into the final statement: the voices of the Man and Woman are united together at last, though Life will have its last say.


